

FORMING THE CHARACTER OF DISCIPLINE AND LEARNING MOTIVATION WITH CREATIVITY THROUGH MAKING A WISHING TREE PROFILE PANCASILA STUDENTS

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ABSTRACT

From the activity of making a wishing tree project, positive things that can be obtained are that it can form the disciplined character of students, motivate them to be creative through wishing trees. Besides that the positive things that are also obtained are being able to establish and build collaboration between students and students to both complete the wish tree properly and according to what is desired. The values that can be learned in the activity of making a wishing tree project are the values of humanity and cooperation, in which in making a wishing tree the students work together to finish making a wishing tree. The value of creativity, the value of creativity that is obtained is that students can be creative through making wish trees by cutting cardboard paper and decorating tree branches so that they become beautiful wish trees. Discipline value, the discipline value obtained is that students can become more disciplined and not neglect education so they can reach the goals they want to achieve.

INTRODUCTION

By making a wishing tree project, students can invite students to be creative by playing. Playing can help students in developing student skills, by playing can also cause fun for students in the Hurlock project making activities in Tadkiroatun Musfiroh (2008: 1) suggests that playing is an activity carried out on the basis of pleasure and without considering the end result. Playing can also improve development in children, so students can be creative while playing. Vygotsky (Sofia Hartati. 2005: 15-16) believes that play directs development. Playing can also help students succeed in being creative. Playing according to Mulyadi (2004), in general is often associated with children's activities that are carried out spontaneously (Kurnia, 2012). According to Bettelheim, in Hurlock, play activities are activities that do not have other rules except those set by the game

itself, where there is no intended final result in external reality (Oktarina & Latipah, 2021) (Wiwik Pratiwi, 2017). According to Plato, Aristotle, Froebel in Mayke S. (2007: 2) considers playing as an activity that has practical value. This means that playing is used as a medium to improve certain skills and abilities in children (Priyanto, 2014). The success of creativity according to Amabile (Munandar, 2004: 77) is the intersection between children's skills in a certain field (domain skills), creative thinking and work skills, and intrinsic motivation. (Priyanto, 2014) Teach creative wish trees to students it's easier when students are elementary school aged, because students at elementary school age prefer to imitate and understand more easily to do something creative. This is also an age that likes to imitate, students like to imitate the speech and actions of other people (AM, Yayuk, & Worowirastri, 2016, p. 385). (Marliani, Siagian, 2017) Application and notification of expectations to students at elementary school age is very good because elementary school age children should have hope to be achieved in the future. Hope is a dream that can be realized in the real world, as Asistotle (384-322 BC) once expressed. (Muttaqin, 2022). Apart from teaching students to set goals or hopes, we also teach students to be disciplined so that they can achieve what they hope for in the real world. Discipline is an action that shows obedience or adherence to rules (Anitah, et al., 2009). Disciplined students will create a calm classroom environment that allows students to study well and achieve better results (Baumann & Krskova, 2016). (Sukma et al., 2022). According to Hasibuan (2013: 193), discipline is a person's awareness and willingness to comply with all applicable company regulations and social norms . (Catio & Sunarsi, 2020) Education is a very important thing in human life, this means that Indonesian people also has the right to be educated and to be a person that can be expected by the family and the nation. Education is very important especially for the age of children, with education children can achieve the goals they want. Ideals are something that already exists that we have hoped for from the age of children, with aspirations of being able to encourage children to continue learning and so that they can achieve what they hope to achieve. According to Mutaningtyas (2007), ideals are desires that are always in the mind or goals set by someone for themselves and want to be achieved. The existence of ideals, apart from being supported by dreams, is also influenced by the surrounding environment, especially parents. so we took the theme of the wishing tree so that we could find out what each grade 5A student wanted, we directed them to write down the goals they wanted to achieve. And the students were very enthusiastic in writing down their goals. Some wanted to be doctors, veterinarians, teachers, policewomen, and almost all male students wanted to become soldiers. Why did we take this theme with the title "forming discipline character and learning motivation with creativity through the making of a pancasila student profile hope tree" we took this theme and title, because the facts on the ground are that the aspirations of every human being are different, many children who have big aspirations but often neglect education and are not disciplined in life, especially to achieve what they have hoped for. With this wishing tree it can also motivate students to continue learning, "Learning motivation is a psychological condition that encourages a person to learn" (Khodijah, 2014: 150) . form discipline and motivation to learn with creativity to students. According to Duncan in his book Organizational Behavior Purwanto (1996: 72) suggests that: "Motivation means every conscious effort to influence someone to increase their ability to the maximum to achieve goals" (Rumhadi, 2017). Form student discipline so that they do not neglect education so that the goals they hope they can achieve in the future. In terms of motivation to learn, with this title we hope to motivate students to continue their education so that they can become successful people and reach their goals. Motivation to learn with creativity can help them to always be creative in life. We took the theme of making this wishing tree project in order to teach students about decision making, because having a wishing tree can encourage students to make decisions about what they want to achieve in the future.

According to Eisenfuhr (Lunenburg , 2010) Eisenfuhr's definition of decision-making is the process of making choices from several options to achieve the desired result. (Nahda et al., 2022) The benefits of the activities

of making the Wishing Tree Project are that it can form the character of student discipline, and motivate learning students with creativity through the wishing tree. Self-discipline according to Jasin (1989) is a discipline that is developed or controlled by oneself (Helmi, 2011).

According to Handoko (2014: 208), discipline is a management activity to carry out organizational standards (Catio & Sunarsi, 2020). The benefits obtained are that students can be creative with cartons and tree branches. And student motivation is increasing. According to Mangkunegara (2013: 93) Motivation is an encouragement of needs within employees that need to be fulfilled so that these employees can adapt to their environment. Meanwhile, according to Hasibuan (2013:150) there are two types of motivation, namely direct motivation is motivation (material and non-material) which is given directly to each individual employee to meet their needs and satisfaction. (Catio & Sunarsi, 2020). According to Solso (Csikszentmihalyi, 1996) creativity is a cognitive activity that produces a new perspective on a problem or situation. According to Drevdal (in Hurlock, 1999) explains creativity as a person's ability to produce any composition, product, or idea that is basically new, and previously unknown to the maker (Kurnia, 2012). The success of creativity according to Amabile (Munandar, 2004: 77) is the intersection between children's skills in certain fields (domain skills), creative thinking and working skills, and intrinsic motivation (Priyanto, 2014)

Data Collection Data collection techniques in research This includes observation at the research location. The data collection methods used by researchers to obtain the expected data for this study are as follows: Observation, can be interpreted as systematic observation and recording of the phenomenon being studied (Koentjaraningrat, Community Research Methods 1991:44), which is called observation. This includes activities that use all of the senses to focus on the subject. The observation method is experience and systematic recording of the symptoms that appear on the object of research.
